



KNOWN HAZARDS AT 400'

When departing the Hobie Cove Ramp, do not sail south of a westerly line drawn from the end of the ramp. Areas between the shore and the red lines indicate hazard areas which may be shallow or contain unmarked hazards. This diagram should not be used for navigational purposes and does not replace the course chart indicated in the sailing instructions. It is the skipper's sole responsibility to understand the requirements of their own vessel and to maintain a proper draft.
