INVITATION

The Folsom Lake Yacht Club invites sailors and their familiar to the Trans-Folsom Regatta at Folsom Lake State Recreation Area (Brown's Ravine).

1. Notice and Conditions of Race

1.1. The Folsom Lake Yacht Club Trans-Folsom Regatta Committee shall represent the Folsom Lake Yacht Club (FLYC) as the Regatta Organization Authority. This Committee shall have the authority to accept, reject or rescind any boat entry prior to the start of the first race, and interpret the rules and conditions of the race. Notice is hereby given that all competitors (including spectators, officials, and others) participate in this event solely at their own risk. It is the sole responsibility of the skipper of each yacht to decide whether or not to start or continue in any race.

2. Anticipated Classes

2.1. Self-righting keelboats including: Santana 20, Catalina 22, Open Cruiser and Open Keel

3. Rules, Event Classification

3.1. This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 (RRS), the Prescription of US Sailing Association; the Rules of the participating classes, The Notice of Race (except as modified by the Sailing Instructions), and by the Sailing Instructions.

3.2. The Regatta is designated as a Category A, RRS Appendix G.

4. Eligibility

4.1. The Trans-Folsom is an Open Regatta.

4.1.1. All FLYC established/qualified keelboat fleets are invited to participate.

4.1.2. Any keelboat may participate and must be a member of a Yacht/Sailing Club or the National Authority, as required by Rule 75 of the RRS.

4.1.3. Any ocean capable multihull at least 20 feet length overall and at least 15 feet wide and must be a member of a Yacht/Sailing Club or the National Authority, as required by Rule 75 of the RRS.

4.2. Because of the distance involved, centerboard and under 19 feet catamaran boats may not register to compete in the event.

4.3. There is no limit on the number of participating boats, but skippers are strongly urged to pre-register.

- 4.4. A minimum of four (4) legitimate entries must be received not later than March 31, 2018 to qualify a Class for a One-Design Fleet. If the number of entries seeking to constitute a One-Design Fleet fails to meet this minimum requirement, the entries will be registered in an Open Class.
- 4.5. If you have a stock boat with an established PHRF rating, you do not need a certificate. In any other case PHRF Fleet Keel Boats must complete a FLYC certificate upon registration (see www.flyc.org) or provide a copy of a current/valid PHRF Certificate. Submit any questions regarding PHRF with your registration.
- 4.6. Boats will be given starting times using current Southern California "buoy" base PHRF ratings.
- 4.7. PHRF and Cruiser Fleet boats will be divided into divisions based on number of entries.

5. Entry Fee

- 5.1. Entry fee is \$20 for FLYC members. \$22 for non-members.
- 5.2. Return entry forms with check made payable to: Folsom Lake Yacht Club. PHRF entrants, please include copies of your current or FLYC PHRF certificate (available at www.flyc.org).

6. Registration

- 6.1. Deadline: 8:30 AM prior to the skipper's meeting.
- 6.2. Open to all rated and One-Design keelboats.
- 6.3. Check-in: At Regatta Headquarters on Saturday, March 30, 2019 from 7:30 AM to 8:30 AM. All entrants must check in at Regatta Headquarters.
- 6.4. No changes, including changes to ratings, are allowed after 9:00 AM.
- 6.5. Sailing instructions and a course chart will be posted at www.flyc.org and will be available at check-in.

7. Racing

- 7.1. One, 21 mile pursuit race on Saturday (conditions permitting)
- 7.2. The Race Committee may combine boats in Open Keel divisions for more competitive racing as follows:
 - 7.2.1. Red Open Keel (PHRF 100 to 189)
 - 7.2.2. Blue Open Keel (PHRF 190 and above)
 - 7.2.3. Cruiser (PHRF 200+)

8. Courses, Starts and Finishes

- 8.1. One course as described in the Trans-Folsom Course Sheet.

9. Sailing Instructions

- 9.1. Sailing Instructions will be on or before March 1, 2019 on the FLYC web site (www.flyc.org) , and will be supplied with course chart upon check-in.
- 9.2. Changes to sailing instructions will be posted upon the "Official Notice Board" no later than 9:00 AM on race day.

10. Safety

- 10.1. A 15' painter or equivalent line must be carried on board to aid in rescue
- 10.2. Boats must either have a boarding ladder on board or be designed for water level boarding to rescue swimmers.
- 10.3. Should the Race Committee display a Yankee signal flag (red and yellow diagonal stripes), all competitors must wear PFDs.
- 10.4. Non-compliance by any competitor with any of these Safety rules will subject the vessel to protest and disqualification.

11. Scoring

- 11.1. All boats will be scored/placed in the order they finish.
- 11.2. If the course is shortened, scoring/placement will be based on corrected time using 'time on time'.

12. Schedule of Events

- 12.1. Saturday March 30, 2019

- 12.1.1. 7:30 AM - 8:30 AM – Late Registration and Check-in
- 12.1.2. 9:00 AM – Skipper’s Meeting
- 12.1.3. 10:00 AM – Start of Pursuit Race
- 12.1.4. Following Race – Awards Presentation and Refreshments at Regatta Headquarters

13. Trophies

13.1. Trophies will be awarded based on class participation:

1-4 Starters	1 Trophy
5-7 Starters	2 Trophies
8-10 Starters	3 Trophies
11-15 Starters	4 Trophies
16+ Starters	5 Trophies

13.2. The Trans-Folsom Regatta Perpetual Trophy will be awarded based on the best finish.

14. Location & State Park Fees

14.1. Regatta Headquarters will be the FLYC Clubhouse overlooking Brown’s Ravine launch ramp at the Folsom Lake Marina, off Green Valley Road in El Dorado Hills, CA.

14.2. Directions:

- 14.2.1. From Sacramento: take US 50 East. Exit at Folsom Blvd (exit 23). Continue North 1.5 miles on Folsom Blvd to Blue Ravine. Drive North on Blue Ravine 6.7 miles. At El Dorado County, Blue Ravine becomes Green Valley Road. The entrance to Brown’s Ravine is 0.8 miles past the Purple Place (a bar on the North side of Green Valley Road), approximately halfway between The Purple Place and Francisco Drive in El Dorado Hills.
- 14.2.2. From Roseville/Auburn, take Folsom-Auburn road South. Turn left onto Folsom Dam road, passing the dam and continuing to Blue Ravine road. Turn left on Blue Ravine/Green Valley road and continue 2.2 miles to Brown’s Ravine.
- 14.2.3. From South Lake Tahoe/Placerville, take US 50 West, exit at El Dorado Hills Blvd (exit 30) and travel North to El Dorado Hills Blvd (4.7 miles) to Green Valley road. Turn left and continue 0.7 miles to Brown’s Ravine.

14.3. California State Park day use fees are collected at Brown’s Ravine access gate to Folsom Lake State Recreation area; day use \$12/car, \$22/car and boat.

14.4. Launch ramp procedures are found at www.folsomlakemarina.com/ramp_rules.html

14.5. No self-contained RV camping is available at Brown’s Ravine parking lot.

14.6. The nearest camp sites (tent) at Folsom Lake SRA are at Beal’s Point on Auburn-Folsom road in Granite Bay, North side of the lake. Allow 30 minutes to drive to Brown’s Ravine from Beal’s Point. Do not sail across the lake, as you’ll never arrive in time.

14.7. For campsites at Beal’s Point call 800-444-7275. Boat camping at anchor is allowed in Brown’s Ravine by checking in at the Marina Office in advance.
